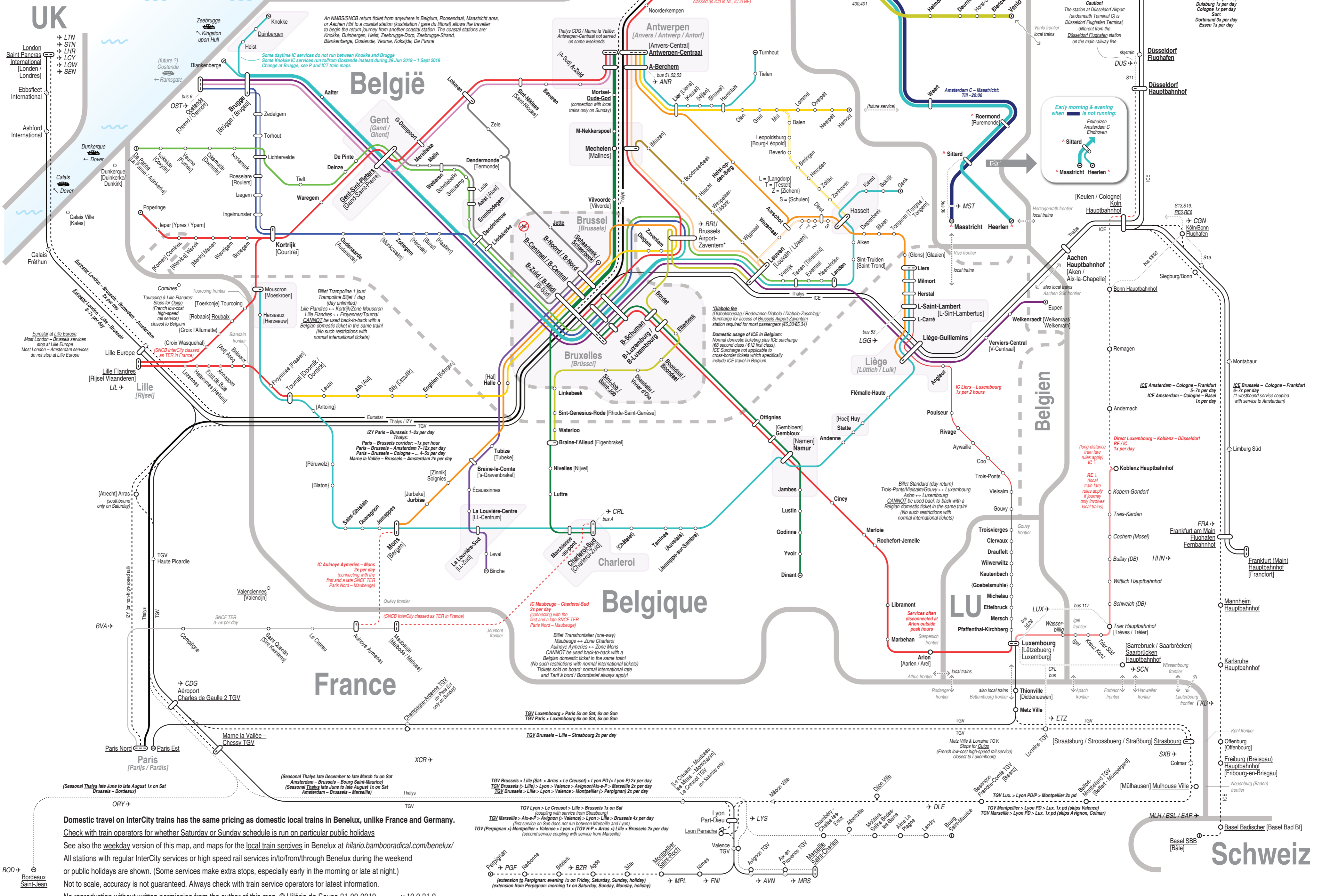

- Station with InterCity and/or high-speed rail services
- Station also served by regular local trains in / to / from Benelux (see local train maps)

- Station served by InterCity services (only during the weekend)
- Station with metro / pre-metro / S-Bahn / U-Bahn / Stadtbahn / light-rail / tram / funicular connections
- Station with NS and non-NS OV-chipkaart check-in portals
- Trains stop here only when travelling in one direction
- Only some services stop here
- Train reverses out of a station (furthest possible terminus)

- Service frequency (unless otherwise qualified):
 - 2 train services per hour per direction
 - 1 train service per hour per direction
 - 1 train service per 2 hours per direction
 - 1 per hour on Saturdays, 1 per 2 hours on Sundays
 - operates on Saturdays only

- Two separate services: A – B, and C – D
- Train service splits into two / train services combine into one (for InterCity services only)
- Coordinated cross-platform transfer between InterCity services in the same direction
- Zone of single tariff point; NMBS/SNCB grants the holder of a domestic or international train ticket with an origin/destination in a Zone, on the ticket's day of validity, free travel on NMBS/SNCB trains within that Zone until they leave the Zone

- Airport / North Sea ferry port with regular passenger services
- Only selected land-connections run by regular public transport operators are shown
- When more than one option is shown, the better option(s) is/are underlined
- See port and flight / ferry operator websites for more access options



Domestic travel on InterCity trains has the same pricing as domestic local trains in Benelux, unlike France and Germany. Check with train operators for whether Saturday or Sunday schedule is run on particular public holidays.
