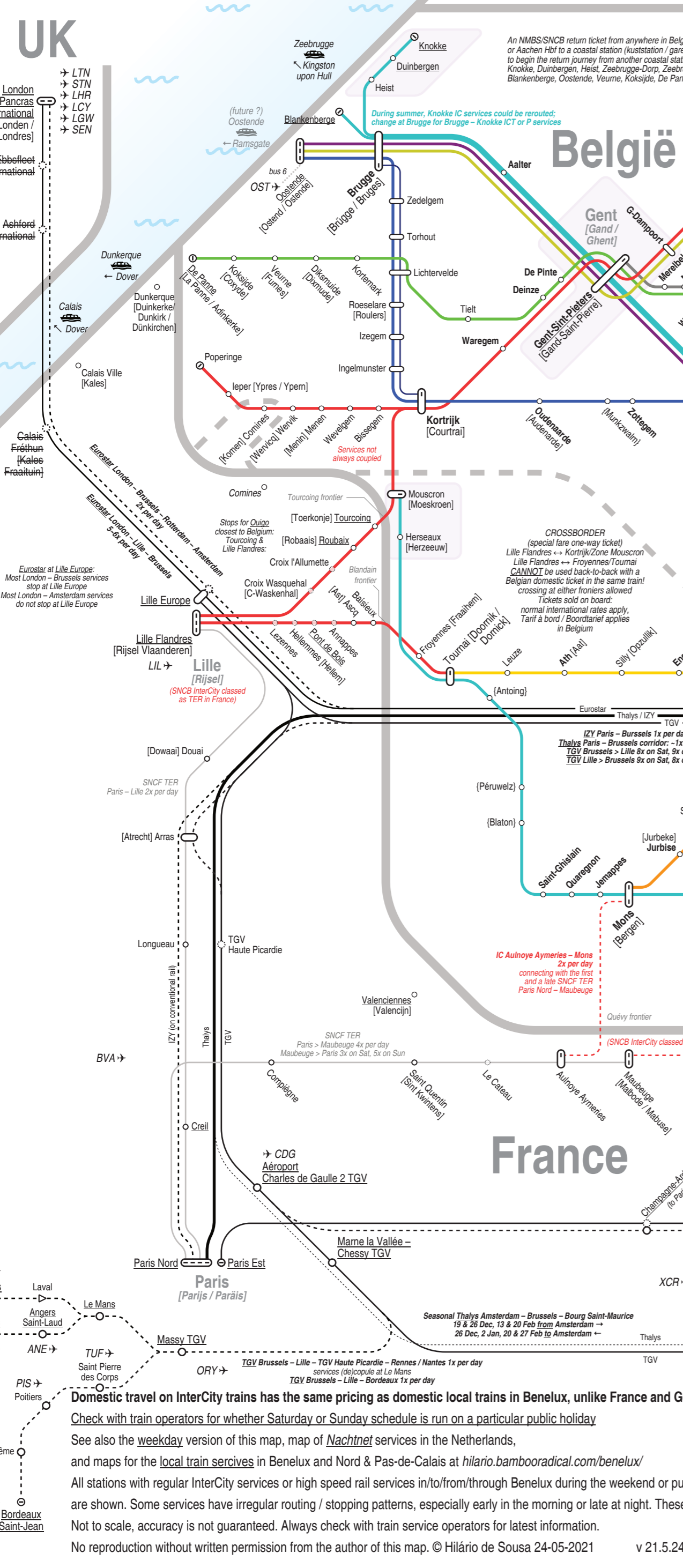
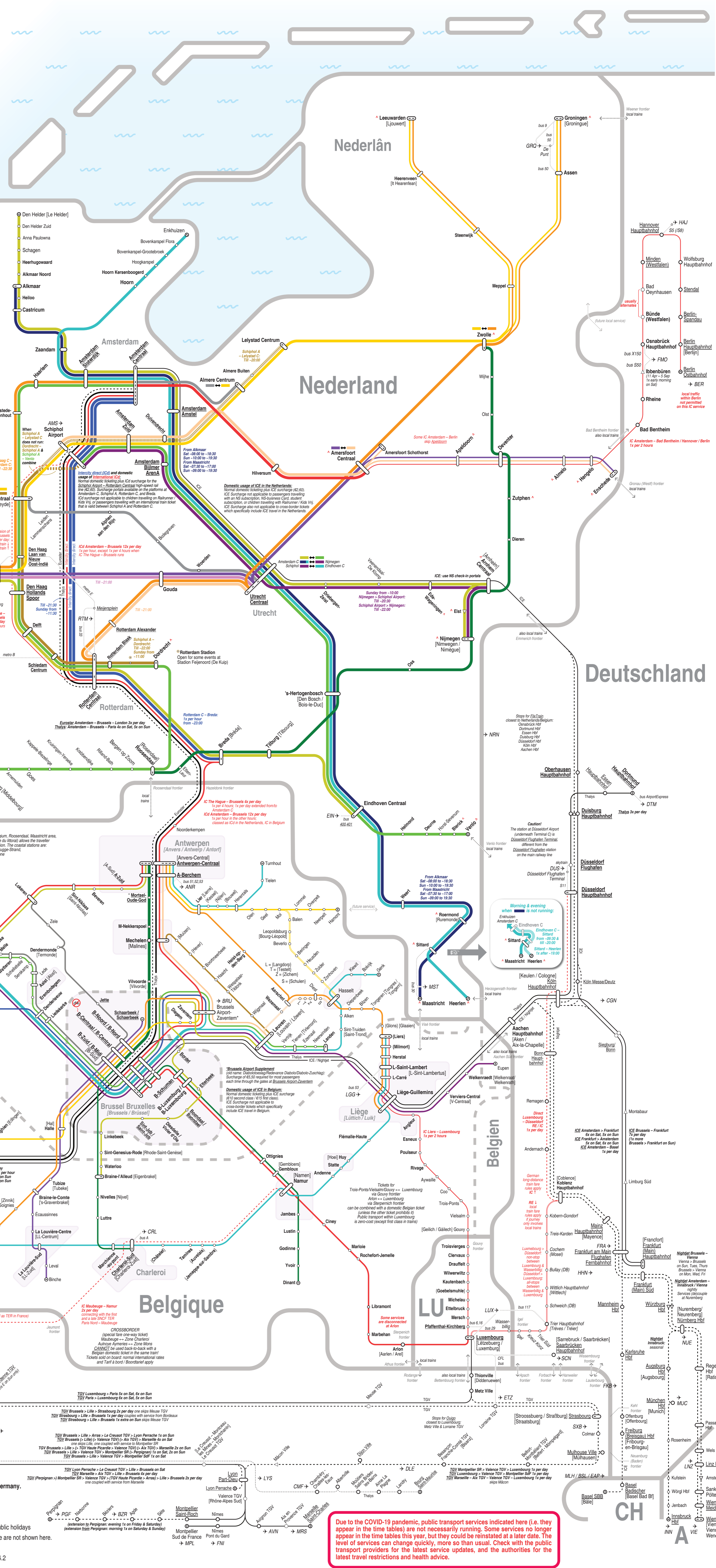
Service frequency (unless otherwise qualified):

- 2 train services per hour per direction
- 1 train service per hour per direction
- 1 train service per 2 hours per direction
- 1 per hour on Saturdays, 1 per 2 hours on Sundays
- operates on Saturdays only

- different thickness: two separate services, A – B, and C – D
- same thickness, for InterCity only: one train decouples into two / two trains couple into one
- coordinated cross-platform transfer between InterCity services in the same direction

Zone of single tariff point; NMBS/SNCB grants the holder of a domestic or international train ticket with an origin/destination in a zone, on the ticket's day of validity, free travel on NMBS/SNCB trains within that Zone until they leave the Zone
