Zone of single tariff point; NMBS/SNCB grants the holder of a domestic or international train ticket with an origin/destination in a Zone, on the tickets day of validity, free travel on NMBS/SNCB trains within that Zone until they leave the Zone

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, public transport services indicated here (i.e. they appear in the time tables) are not necessarily running. Some services no longer appear in the time tables this year, but they could be reinstated at a later date. The level of services can change quickly, more so than usual. Check with the public transport providers for the latest service updates, and the authorities for the latest travel restrictions and health advice.

"P" trains are the numerous commuter-oriented train services that supplement the regular InterCity and local train services (S and L trains) in Belgium. Their routing and stopping pattern are often different from the normal train services, and they run primarily during peak hours. P trains that run before the afternoon peak have train numbers 7xxx, and P trains that run during or after the afternoon peak have 8xxx. Also included in this map are S trains that have 7xxx or 8xxx train numbers.

International trains that run between Belgium and Luxembourg have the same train numbers in both countries. Amongst these international trains, trains that are classified as P in Belgium are classified in Luxembourg as:

- IC (InterCity) for line **B14**
- RE (Regional-Express) for lines **LX1c**
- RB (RegionalBunn) for line **LX1d**
