The Sunday P trains and the ICT (tourist) trains are two small networks of trains in Belgium, and they are temporally largely mutually exclusive.

The Sunday P trains are supplementary services aimed at transporting students back to their tertiary institution on Sunday evenings. They run during non-vacation periods. They have the train numbers 8xxx, similar to the weekday evening P trains.

The ICT (tourist) trains are seasonal services running to and from popular tourist destinations. They run primarily during the Summer vacation period, some running every day during this period. Additional ICT trains can be put on at short notice. They have the train numbers 66xx, 67xx, 68xx, and 69xx.
