



Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, public transport services indicated here (i.e. they appear in the time tables) are not necessarily running. Some services no longer appear in the time tables this year, but they could be reinstated at a later date. The level of services can change quickly, more so than usual. Check with the public transport providers for the latest service updates, and the authorities for the latest travel restrictions and health advice.
