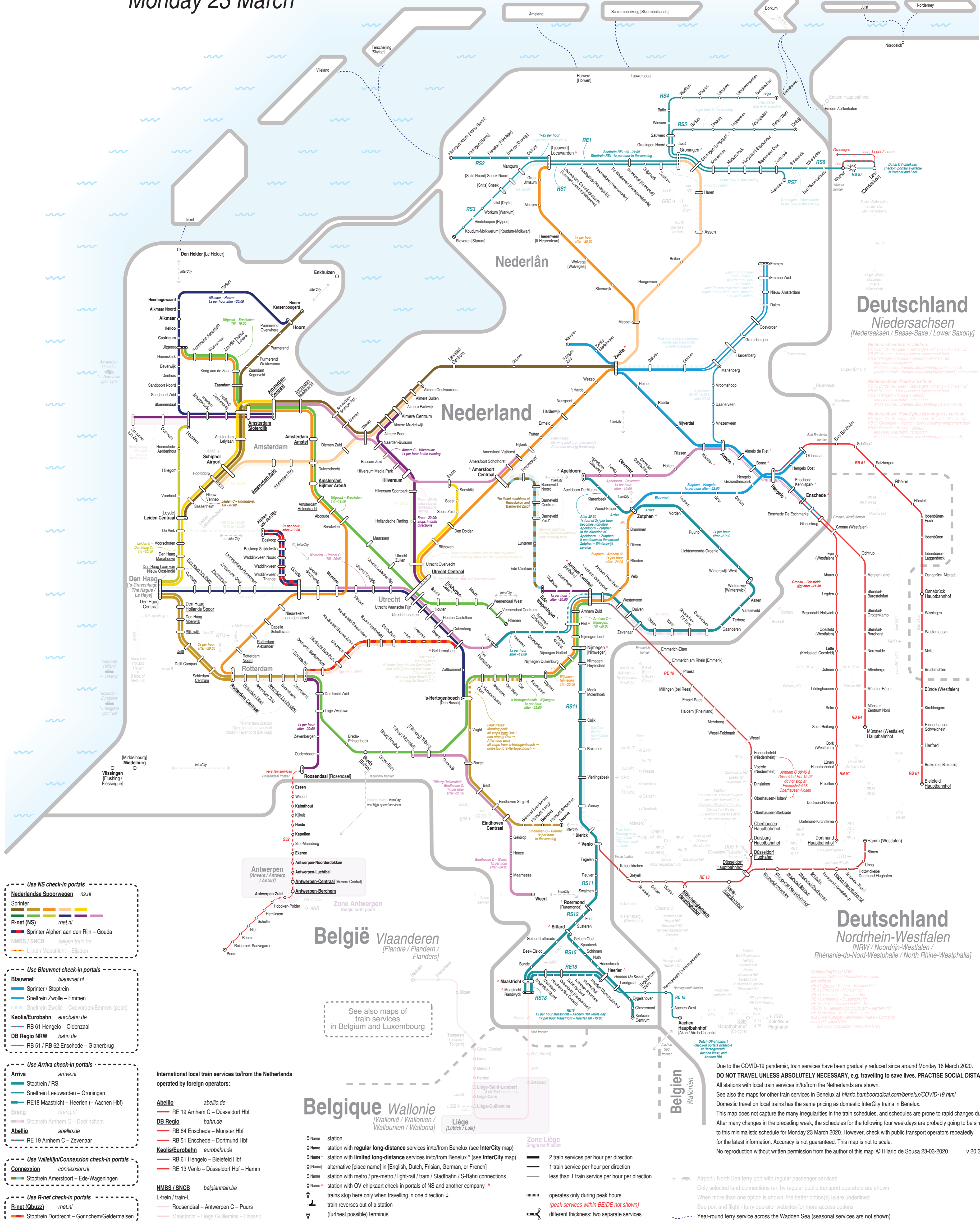


# Sprinter train services of Nederlandse Spoorwegen and local train services of other operators in the Netherlands 2020

- Belgique Wallonie** (Wallonië / Wallonien / Wallounien / Wallonia)
- Name station
  - station with regular long-distance services in/to/from Belgium (see InterCity map)
  - station with limited long-distance services in/to/from Belgium (see InterCity map)
  - alternative (place name) in English, Dutch, Frisian, German, or French
  - Name station with metro / pre-metro / light-rail / tram / Stadtbahn / S-Bahn connections
  - station with OV-chipkaart check-in portals of NS and another company
  - trains stop here only when travelling in one direction
  - trains reverse out of a station (furthest possible) terminus
- Zone Liège** Single tariff point
- 2 train services per hour per direction
  - 1 train service per hour per direction
  - less than 1 train service per hour per direction
- Zone Antwerpen** Single tariff point
- operates only during peak hours (peak services within BE/DE not shown)
  - different thickness: two separate services

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, train services have been gradually reduced since around Monday 16 March 2020. **DO NOT TRAVEL UNLESS ABSOLUTELY NECESSARY, e.g. travelling to save lives. PRACTISE SOCIAL DISTANCING.** All stations with local train services in/to/from the Netherlands are shown. Domestic travel on local trains has the same pricing as domestic InterCity trains in Belgium. This map does not capture the many irregularities in the train schedules, and schedules are prone to rapid changes during this crisis. After many changes in the preceding week, the schedules for the following four weekdays are probably going to be similar to this minimalistic schedule for Monday 23 March 2020. However, check with public transport operators repeatedly for the latest information. Accuracy is not guaranteed. This map is not to scale.
