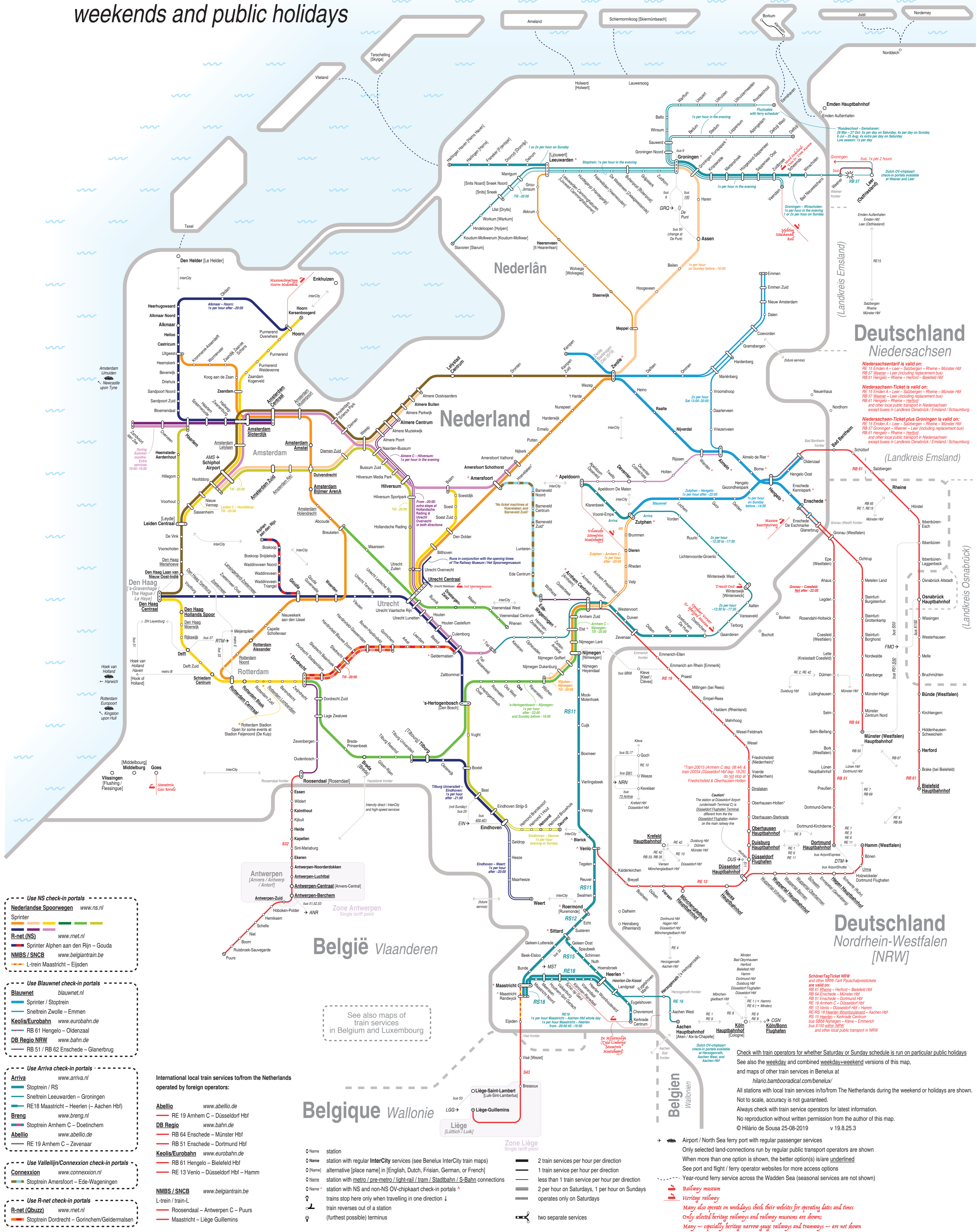

- station
  - station with regular Intercity services (see Benelux Intercity train maps)
  - alternative (place name) in English, Dutch, Frisian, German, or French
  - station with metro / pre-metro / light-rail / tram / Stadtbahn / S-Bahn connections
  - station with NS and non-NS OV-chipkaart check-in portals
  - trains stop here only when travelling in one direction
  - trains reverse out of a station (furthest possible) terminus

- 2 train services per hour per direction
- 1 train service per hour per direction
- less than 1 train service per hour per direction
- 2 per hour on Saturdays, 1 per hour on Sundays
- operates only on Saturdays
- two separate services

Check with train operators for whether Saturday or Sunday schedule is run on particular public holidays.
