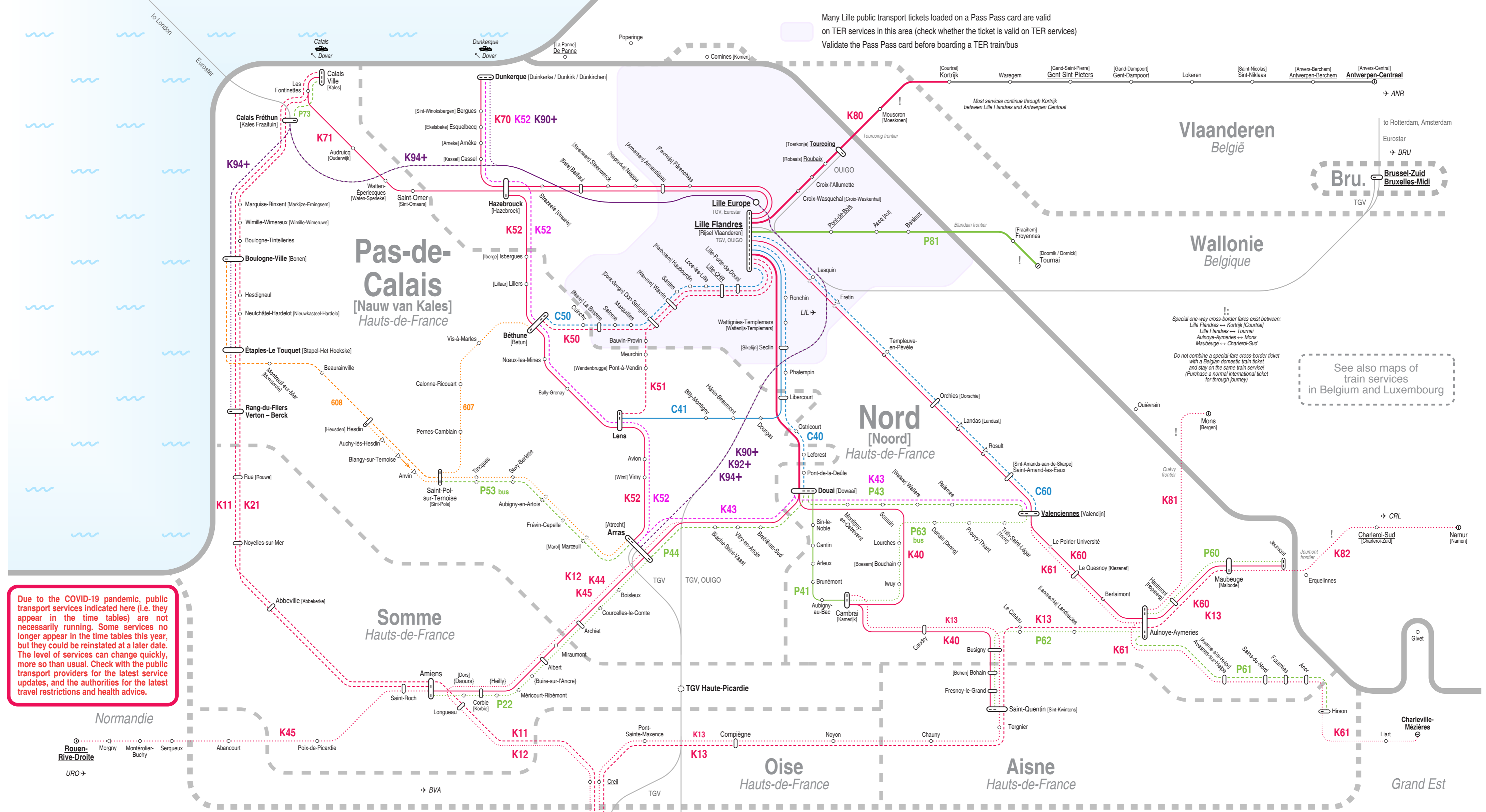


Many Lille public transport tickets loaded on a Pass Pass card are valid on TER services in this area (check whether the ticket is valid on TER services)  
 Validate the Pass Pass card before boarding a TER train/bus



Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, public transport services indicated here (i.e. they appear in the time tables) are not necessarily running. Some services no longer appear in the time tables this year, but they could be reinstated at a later date. The level of services can change quickly, more so than usual. Check with the public transport providers for the latest service updates, and the authorities for the latest travel restrictions and health advice.

- ◇ Name station
  - ◇ Name station with high-speed rail services
  - ◇ (Name) alternative [place name] in [Dutch / English / German] (in Flanders: [French])
  - ◇ Name station with metro / pre-metro / tram / RER connections
  - ◇ (Name) station with services to/from Nord & Pas-de-Calais (only during the weekend)
  - ⚡ some services of this line stop here
  - ⚡ trains stop here only when travelling in one direction ↓
  - ↔ train reverses out of a station
  - Ⓜ (furthest possible) terminus
- For TER services in/to/from Nord & Pas-de-Calais:
- 12 ≤ train services < 18
  - 6 ≤ train services < 12
  - - - 3 ≤ train services < 6
  - ⋯ 0 < train services < 3
  - per day per direction on average

- **KRONO+GV** High-speed rail service at TER tariff (TERGV), with TERGV supplement (€2 one way) for each arrival or departure at Lille Europe
- **KRONO** Conventional TER service, stopping at larger stations
- **CITI** TGVAUT: conventional-rail continuation of TGV service to/from Paris Nord; ordinary TER tariff applies
- **PROXI** Frequent TER service around big cities
- **RRT**: bus not run by SNCF TER; TER tariff applies
- Normal high-speed rail service (dynamic pricing)

 Transport express régional (TER) Hauts-de-France *ter.sncf.com/hauts-de-france*  
**Nationale Maatschappij der Belgische Spoorwegen / Société nationale des chemins de fer belges (NMBS/SNCF)** *belgiantrain.be, b-europe.com*  
 All conventional Franco-Belgian cross-border services are run by NMBS/SNCF; these are classed as *TER* in France, and *Intercity* in Belgium
