



# P train services in Belgium early 2025

## Monday to Friday

P-train (piekturein) / Train P (train d'heure de pointe) / P-Zug (Zug des Spitzenverkehrs):  
 P trains in Belgium are irregular passenger train services which supplement the regular (usually hourly) EC, IC, S, and L train services. Listed here are the individual P train services. P services often have different routing and/or stopping patterns than the regular services. P services that start before 15:00 have the train number 7xxx, and those after 15:00 have the train number 8xxx. Also included in this map are S trains that have 7xxx or 8xxx numbers. Belgian P trains that cross into Luxembourg have the same number in both countries. In Luxembourg, 7630 and 7613 are classed as IC, while 765x, 765x and 867x are classed as RE. Line names like B7b and LV1 are classifications used only in this map; these are not nomenclature used by Belgian or Luxembourgish train operators. There is a slight decrease in the number of P services over the years. Many have been regularised, e.g. upgraded to run hourly the whole day, became peak extensions of other regular services.

In a list of P-train services:  
 - Name: alternative place name in [Dutch, English, French, German, or Luxembourgish]  
 - Name: no service during the weekend  
 - Name: station only served by P services, no IC services  
 - Name: station has L and/or S services, but no IC services (see map of regular services)  
 - Name: station has IC services (see map of regular services)  
 - Name: trains stop here only when travelling in this direction

'Zone': Single tariff point; a domestic ticket with a zone as the origin and/or destination gives the passenger unlimited travel within the zone before they leave the zone (within the day of train operation), e.g. travelling purely within a zone requires only a single ticket with the zone as the origin and destination. (This no longer applies to international tickets.)  
 (\*) Brussels Airport Supplement: €6.70 surcharge for passing through the passenger gates at Brussels Airport-Zaventem station. Check whether the supplement needs to be purchased if it is not already included in a ticket.  
 Belgium: EC, IC, S, L, P, and T services within Belgium have the same distance-based ticketing. Luxembourg: Domestic public transport in Luxembourg is fare-free, except 1st class train travel: IC, RE, RB, and TER services have the same time-based ticketing. (Belgian buses in Luxembourg do not take domestic passengers.)  
 Check carefully in a journey planner for the latest info. Usually Sunday schedule applies on holidays, but check with train service operators for possible special arrangements. Check at: e.g. belgiantrain.be, cfl.lu
