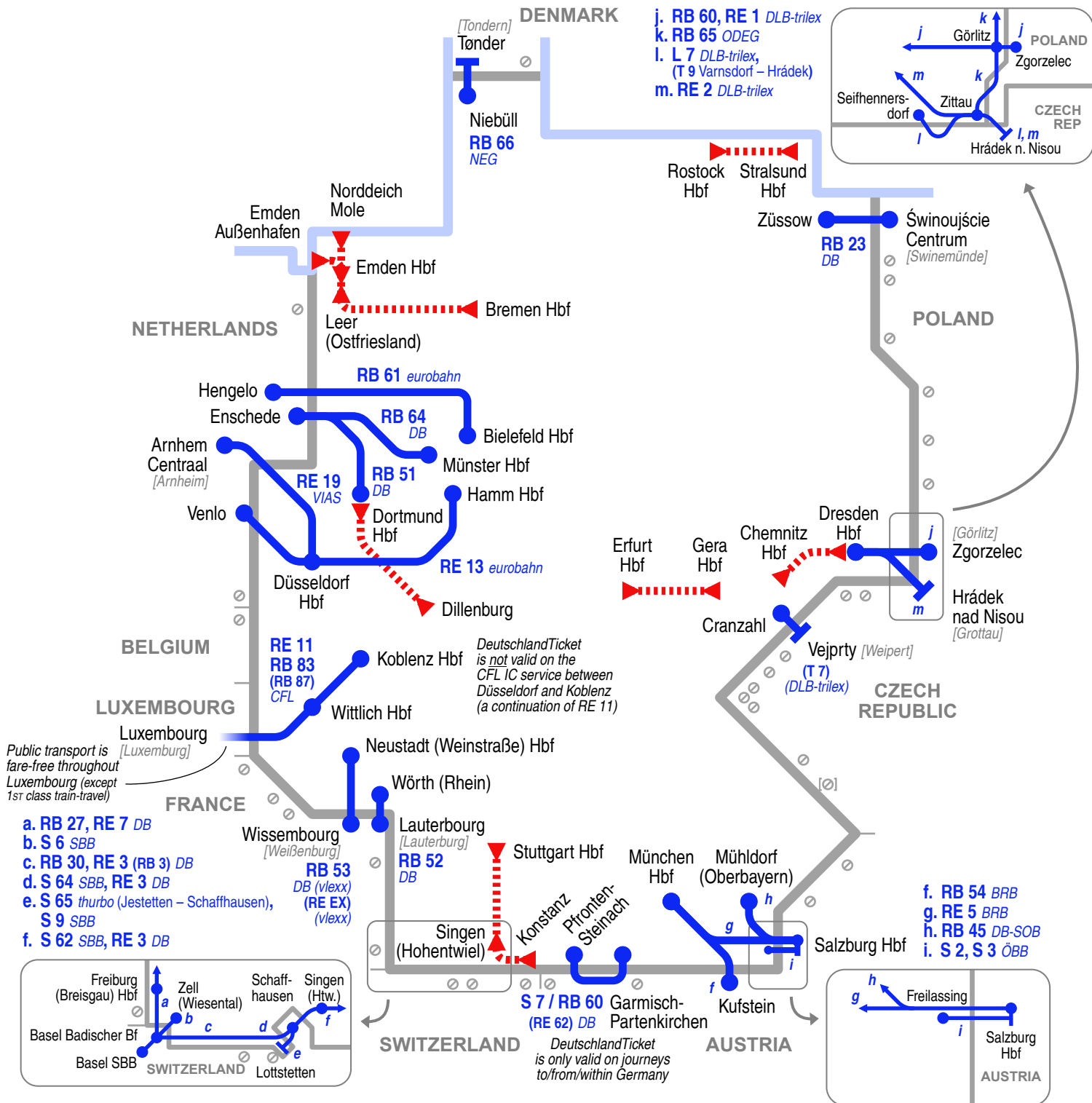




Additional validity of the DeutschlandTicket on trains

The DeutschlandTicket is valid on nearly all *Nahverkehr* (short-distance) bus / tram / U-bahn / train (2ND class) services within Germany
the most-common *Nahverkehr* train types are S, RB, RE; some other *Nahverkehr* train types are RS, RT, IRE, MEX, FEX
set search option to "Nur D-Ticket-Verbindungen" / "D-Ticket services only" in the Deutsche Bahn [DB] journey planner
The validity of other *Nahverkehr* tickets cannot be inferred from that of the DeutschlandTicket, and vice versa

The DeutschlandTicket may also be valid between these two stations on a DB *Fernverkehr* (long-distance) train service (IC / ICE / RJ) that connects these two stations directly.

The DB journey planner states explicitly if the DeutschlandTicket is valid on a section of IC / ICE / RJ service. Some IC / ICE / RJ services carry a *Nahverkehr* number (typically RE) in addition to their IC / ICE / RJ number. However, not all of them accept the DeutschlandTicket, including some which run on the sections shown above.

valid on the entire service
 valid till THIS station
 (RB 3) (limited service)

The DeutschlandTicket is also valid outside Germany on this cross-border *Nahverkehr* train service (with the train operator stated).

⊗: For other railway border-crossing points, the DeutschlandTicket is valid only up to the last station in Germany before the border.
For cross-border bus / tram services, check the validity of the DeutschlandTicket on them, even for journeys entirely within Germany.
